What is the MaRYS program about?

The Migrant and Refugee Youth Support Program assists young people generally not born in Australia, to transition into the workforce successfully by providing them with training, practical skills, work experience and on job mentoring support to get their career underway.

The program runs over 20 weeks with DISCO partnering with a local registered training organisation as well as other community partners to help young people receive vital support to help integrate them successfully into the world of work.

Who is eligible?

To be eligible you must be 15 – 24, struggling to find or obtain work (or consider yourself underemployed) and not studying full time and be either a refugee or humanitarian visa holder or a temporary visa holder or be from a family who has migrated to Australia.

Priority will be given to those young people who have left school.

What help do we provide?

Language and integration Support

Our team members understand the challenges associated with learning how to fit in to a new environment and will work alongside our client with one-on-one support.

Career Advice and Planning

Our staff will develop a Training Plan to assist each client to achieve their goal of undertaking training and moving toward obtaining a job and a career.

Work Experience

Our staff help clients to 'road test' employment opportunities to enable them to find the job that matches their interests and meets their aspirations.

Job Preparation – Support – Mentoring

Preparing for the world of work can be challenging but the MaRYS team members work to build a clients confidence and skills, so they feel supported whilst undertaking training and when they commence work.

Job Placement and Follow Up

After commencing employment, the MaRYS team will remain in touch to ensure everything is working out and provide ongoing support if required.
